



## Basic Information about Mobilities in ECVET-Enterprise Project

The process of mobilities started with **matching**: VET schools finding host companies for their trainees in partner countries. It was important to identify host companies well before so that workplace tutors from these companies could attend training workshop together with their respective partners: VET tutors from schools.

**Training workshop** was attended by VET tutors from schools (sending organizations) and workplace tutors from companies (receiving organizations) representing pairs/tandems of WBL tutors. During the workshop, VET tutor in tandem with workplace tutor learned **to formulate learning outcomes**, and outlined the learning plans for their VET trainees. Unfortunately, not all cases had both tutors.

After the training event, there was time to prepare documentation, to finalize learning plans.

**Mobilities** took place in the period between October 2017 and March 2018. VET trainees had learning periods at the following companies:

After completion of mobilities, VET schools **finalized assessment and validated** the learning outcomes of Trainees.

We initiated **feedback process** to have opinions from VET schools and tutors, workplace tutors, chambers, trainees. The Feedbacks include comments about matching and understanding between schools and companies, about training, communication during all stages, assessment, and validation of learning outcomes. Comments about these aspects, about lessons learned and case descriptions, are included in the Toolset and served as a basis for the Comparative report.
