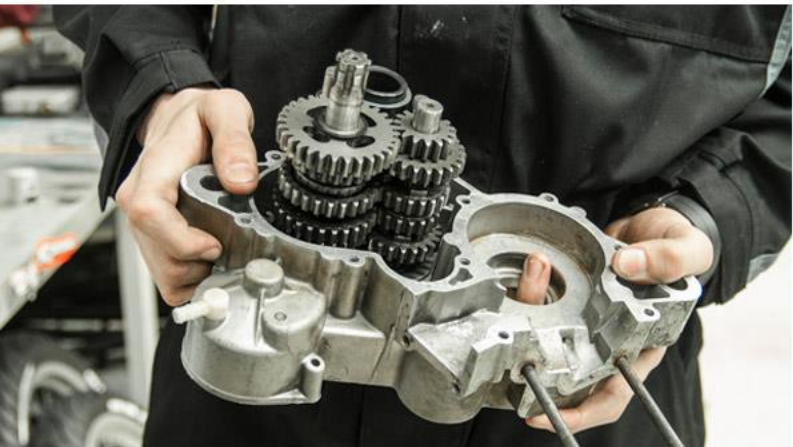

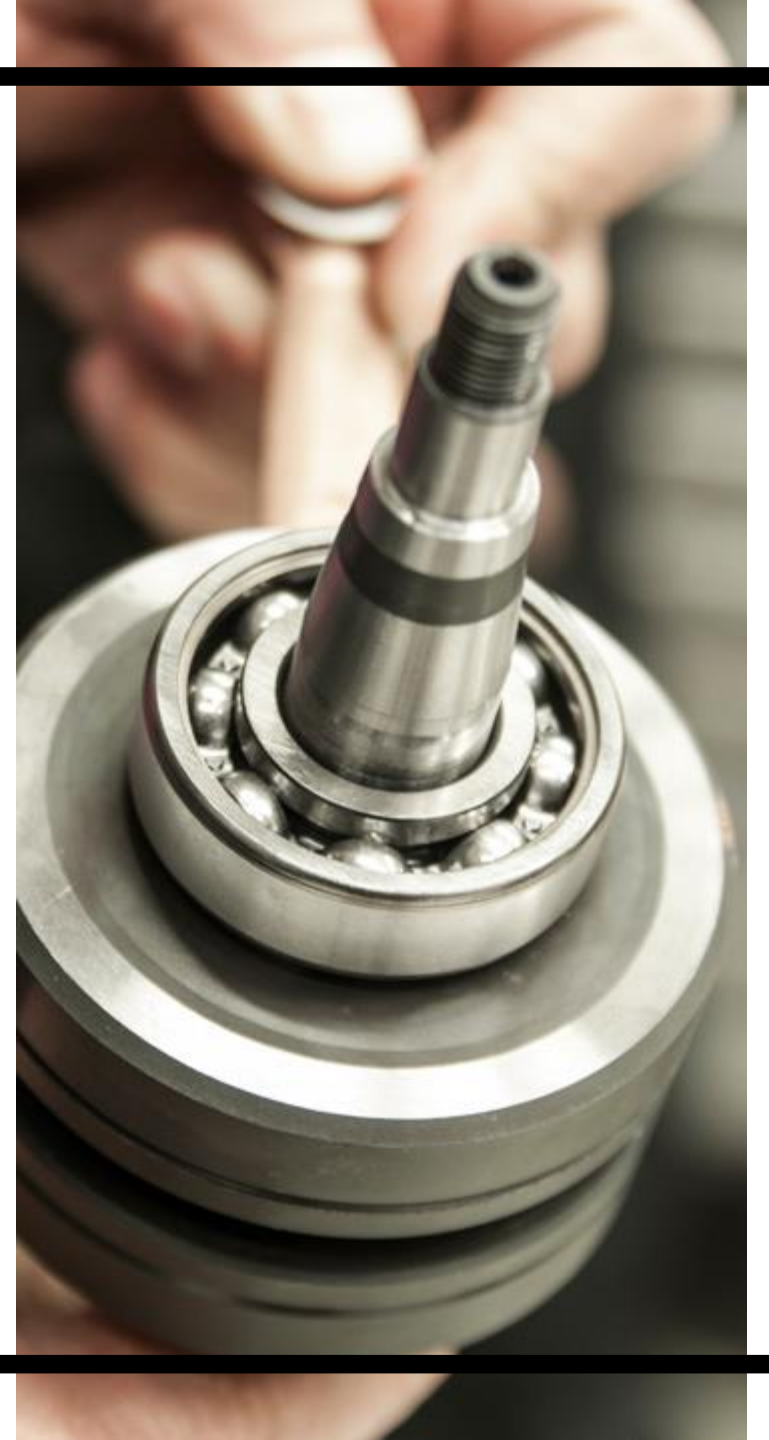




IMPLEMENTATION OF ILP 10.10.2019 WORKSHOP

AIM OF TODAY'S WORKSHOP:

- To find the most valuable themes from this week to implement on own work environment

HOW?

STEP 1: REVISION OF THIS WEEK THEMES: TOOLS - IDEAS

STEP 2: FAMILIARIZE

- Think about what new information you've gained in 4 days
- Think about what is most important to you?
- Why this is important to you? Perhaps this could help you in your work? This could change the whole how you do this in your country?
- Why some things are not as important than others? Is it useless to you? Perhaps you do not have any multicultural student? (really? ;)
- Be ready to discuss (in your own language or in English)



STEP 3: CHOOSE 1-5 BEST IDEAS OR TOOLS

- After thinking, choose 1-5 ideas which you would like to take home with you and start using
- Prepare thoughts with some bullets, why this is important
- Example:
 - ✓ WBL 1st meeting checklist
 - It's ready to use –tool
 - It shows that the WBL needs all the parties
 - Something else, what?



STEP 4: CHOOSE 1-5 BEST IDEAS OR TOOLS

- Choose together 1-5 best ideas or tools for your institution
- Fill up together provided table, think together what you will answer on the questions
- Table is on different paper, you will be handled it on this point 😊



STEP 5: CREATING PRESENTATION

- Choose on your group who will make a presentation at online or PowerPoint / similar
- Use previous table to create the presentation: we are interested about what will you take with you when you leave Espoo 😊
- Compile presentation either in your own language or in English (you'll give presentation today in English, but you can do this also in your own language for further needs – remember, Elise does understand all your languages – taip pat lietuviskai ;))
- Discuss how your presentation will look like (Who is the target group? Is it for your boss / team leader / colleagues?)



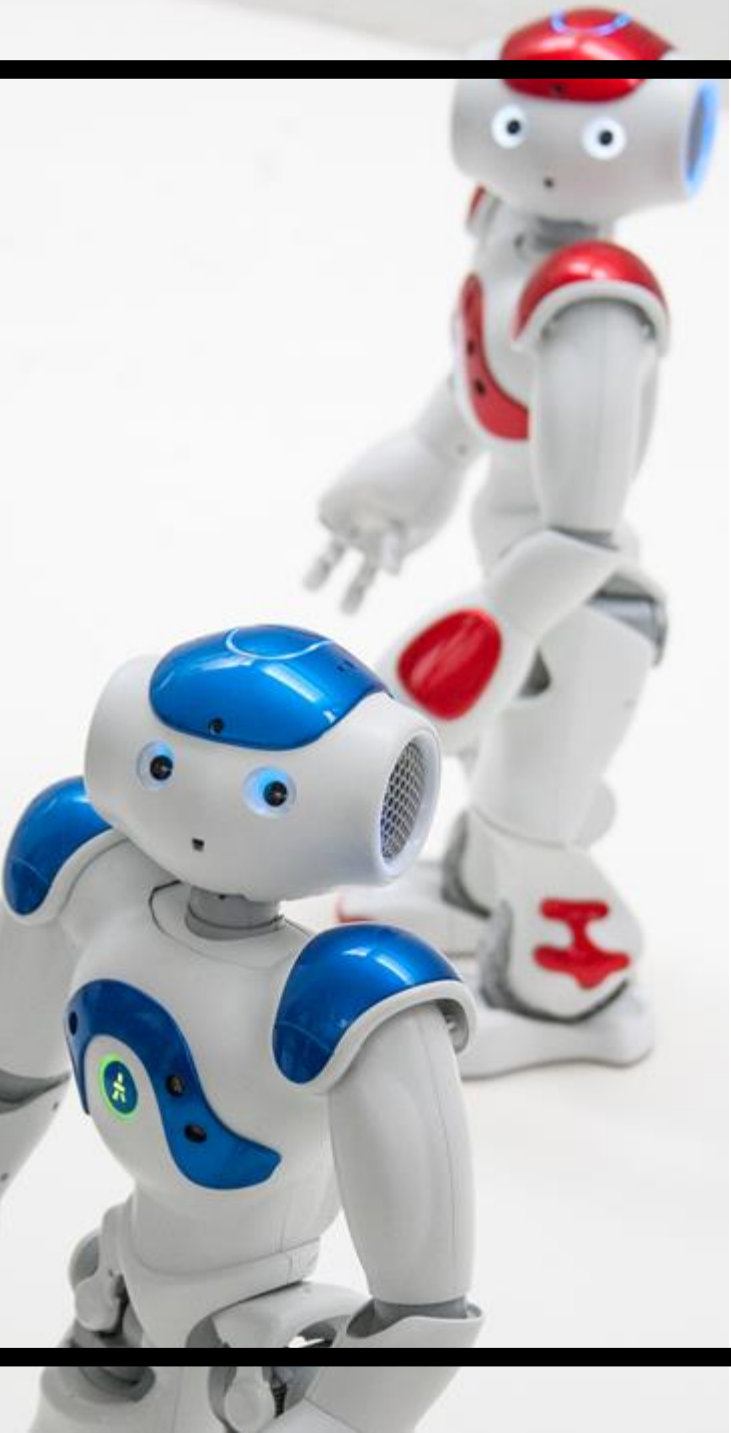
STEP 6: GIVE US THE PRESENTATION
