







COMPETENCE ASSESSMENT

- Vocational qualifications are independent of the way the vocational skills have been acquired
- As long as the individual's competences meet the national qualification requirements, they can be acquired in different learning environments and ways, at different times
- Students demonstrate their skills in competence demonstrations at practical work either at workplace or at the learning institute (such as Omnia)



COMPETENCE: BEFORE THE DEMONSTRATION, FEEDBACK

- Feedback = given by teacher (and/or other personnel of the school such as the guide/instructor) or workplace tutor to the student during the compentence acquirement
- Feedback guides and helps the student to gain his/her goals during study unit



COMPETENCE: DURING THE DEMONSTRATION

- During the demonstration the student shows his/her knowledge and skills by doing practical work in real worklife or work processes (at school, mostly)
- The student shows his/her skills on the study unit requirements
- School is organising the demonstration, it's discussed with the student and with the workplace when demonstration is held and what requirements are going to be shown.
- Student has a right to know when the demonstration is happening
- Typically only the workplace tutor is viewing the demonstration



COMPETENCE: AFTER THE DEMONSTRATION, ASSESSMENT PART #1

- Assessment = giving knowledge about the students knowhow on study unit's, how student have achieved study unit's goals and prepare/teach student to give selfassessment
- Assessment is done by comparing students know-how to the vocational competence requirements of certain unit (see <u>Vocational Qualification in Social and Health Care</u>, Promoting growth and participation, 25 competence points)
- If the assessment has been adjusted (special support, yesterday's lessons) should the student know-how and skills be compared by his/her own criteria mentioned in his/her plan



COMPETENCE: AFTER THE DEMONSTRATION, ASSESSMENT PART #2

- Assessment has to be done as soon as possible after the demonstration by 2 persons, either tutor + teacher or teacher + personnel of the school (this is valid on all vocational studies except common units)
- If the student is dissatisfied on the assessment, he/she has right to ask revision from the assessors (14 days) and after that also right to make correction request from the worklife committee (työelämätoimikunta) (14 days)
- Demonstration and assessment can be rerun, if student has failed the demonstration or he/she would like to raise his/her grade
